



Code of Conduct – Players

The following guidelines are adopted by the Ottawa St. Anthony Italia Soccer Club (Club) for all players participating in our Soccer Program:

1. Players should provide all necessary documentation to the Club required to play at the level they are competing in.
2. Players should promote an enjoyable environment while competing.
3. Players should learn and practice the principles of Fair Play; integrity, fairness and respect for all involved in the game including Officials, Referees, Opponents, Team-mates and Spectators.
4. Players will always demonstrate respect through their actions including:

Officials: never criticize a Referee

Opponents: respect your opponent no matter the outcome of the game.

Coach and Team Officials: listen and communicate with positive attitude.

Team-mates: be supportive and constructive; do not criticize team-mates.

Team: demonstrate your commitment attending all practices and games.

5. Be prepared for games and practices with proper equipment and positive attitude.
6. Always inform your Coach or Team Official if you will be late or absent for games and practices.
7. Never use foul, profane or derogatory language at any time while at practice or during a game. Please remember that your actions represent the Ottawa St. Anthony Italia Soccer Club and yourself. Disrespect or the use of foul language will not be tolerated.
8. Players will be expected to attend discipline hearings, when required and accept final decisions made at these hearings. They will also be responsible for the payment of all fines levied from any governing discipline body
9. Any team involved in a discipline act within the Eastern Ontario District Soccer Association will be responsible for all fines, administrative fees and other resulting consequences.
10. Zero Tolerance: Breaches of the guidelines above may result in disciplinary action by the Club
